Information and materials all students will need to bring to complete the FAFSA or Dream Act Application:

- student's Social Security card and drivers license (or government-issued ID), if available
- parent's Social Security card (if available)
- parent's federal income tax return** or W-2 forms from tax year 2012 (or 2011 to make an estimate)
- records of untaxed income** such as child support, TANF, interest income, veterans non-education benefits, Social Security benefits
- student's W-2 forms, pay records or records of income earned during 2012
- bank account records or statements
- records of stocks, bonds or investments
- business records
- if not a US citizen, bring alien registration card (if available)
- a list of the colleges you are interested in

Remember, to qualify for a Cal Grant you must submit the FAFSA or Dream Act application **and** GPA verification no later than **March 2, 2013**. See your counselor to get a GPA verification.
