In order to begin the tour request process, we request that you complete the form linked above with all necessary information.

Venues such as the White House, State Department, and Pentagon will require the submission of additional security information. My office will collect that information from you for submission at a later date if it is needed. **On August 7, 2010, the White House changed their policy to require that security information be submitted at least 35 days ahead of time. With this in mind, please make sure that you have responded to my office with your security information at least 36 days before your requested White House tour dates.**
