I am requesting funding for the Kammerer Road Extension - Interchange Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Capital SouthEast Connector Joint Powers Authority, located at 10640 Mather Blvd, Suite 120, Mather, CA 95655. The funding would be for Reconstruct ramps and widen structure at the Hood/Franklin Road Interchange at Interstate 5. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it is on the National Highway System, environmentally cleared under the National Environmental Policy Act, and included in an FHWA-approved Federal Transportation Improvement Program.
