Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Fire Training Center Modernization Project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Cosumnes Community Services District located at 8820 Elk Grove Blvd, Elk Grove, CA, 95624. The funding would be used to modernize the William Perry Schulze Fire Training Facility, a 25 year-old modular building that is at the end of its lifecycle, to a permanent building structure that will house training and education services for regional fire training serving all of south Sacramento County and beyond. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will increase the economic opportunity in the region while supporting a stronger more resilient community. It will increase the effectiveness and preparedness of emergency response in the region.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 USC 5305(a)(2).
