Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Broadway Complete Streets – Phase 3 project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Sacramento, located at 915 I Street, 5th Floor, Sacramento, CA 95814. The funding would be used to complete the transformation of Broadway into a multimodal corridor by improving pavement conditions, installing buffered bike lanes, accommodating parking, improving pedestrian crossings and transit amenities, and modernizing traffic signal equipment. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve pavement conditions, modernized signal equipment, crash reductions on a high-injury corridor, safer routes to school, improved transit reliability, and better corridor accessibility for residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under 23 USC 133.
